

PLEASE NOTE: The embark itinerary below is notional. It represents what the majority of guests experience; however flight times will vary based on the carrier's training schedule. We will provide you with any updated schedule changes via email or phone call, when the training schedule is solidified. Unless you receive an email or call within the week prior to the embark, for planning purposes, you can assume the itinerary below is accurate.

DAY ONE:

- 8:15 a.m. Arrive at the Main Gate, Naval Air Station (NAS) North Island. A member of the Public Affairs staff will meet you there. If you are early, please wait in the lot. **Call (619) 347-3630 if there are delays or questions.**
- 8:25 a.m. Transit to the Passenger terminal to drop off luggage, then transit to Commander, Naval Air Forces Headquarters, Building 8.
- 9:00 a.m. Command briefing at the Flag Briefing room. A Naval Aviation Brief is usually presented by a Senior Officer on the staff to provide general information on the Navy and Naval Aviation. (If time allows, guests will tour an aircraft maintenance production line.)
- 11:15 a.m. Transit to the Passenger Terminal (Building 700) for the aircraft and aircrew safety briefs and departure by C-2 aircraft to the aircraft carrier.
- 12:00 p.m. Depart NAS North Island via C-2A
- 1:00 p.m. Land aboard the aircraft carrier for overnight visit.
- 1:00 p.m. Begin carrier embark:
Greeted by ship's Public Affairs Officer
Observe day flight operations
Have lunch/dinner with the ship's crew
Check into staterooms
Tour spaces above the hangar bay
Observe night flight operations

DAY TWO:

7:00 a.m. Continue carrier embark:
Have breakfast with the crew
Tour spaces below the hangar bay
Observe day flight operations

2:30 p.m. (APPROXIMATELY) Board the C-2 aircraft to return to NAS North Island.

3:00 p.m. (APPROXIMATELY) Return to NAS North Island DV Terminal.

3:30 p.m. (APPROXIMATELY) Depart NAS North Island
