EMFK is a Navy Expeditionary (combat support) medical command. Our mission is to provide forward, responsive, quality, expeditionary medical care to coalition military forces, returning ready forces to the fight within the CENTCOM AOR. EMFK is a Level III, 24/7/365 inpatient and outpatient facility with an inpatient capacity of 20 medical-surgical beds, including four intensive care unit beds and a negative pressure isolation room. EMFK supports five Level I/II Troop Medical Clinics (TMCs) throughout the Kuwait Area of Responsibility (AOR).
