SUBJECT: Recertification of Certain USCENTCOM Land Areas as Chargeable Rest and
Recuperation (R&R) Leave Areas

The land areas of Bahrain, Kuwait, Oman, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, United Arab Emirates, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan, and Uzbekistan are recertified as rest and recuperation (R&R) leave areas, continuing from the previous R&R designation period through a one-year period commencing on June 1, 2014, but only for members whose deployment to a country listed above commenced before June 1, 2014. The requirement in Department of Defense Instruction 1327.06, Enclosure 2, paragraph 1j(9)(a)(2), is waived for the countries listed above for a one-year period commencing on June 1, 2014.
