Mr. Armantrout assumed leadership of the Technical Directorate (TD) in October, 2012. Previously, he was the Technical Director of the Joint Program Executive Office Joint Tactical Radio System (JPEO JTRS).

Mr. Armantrout has almost 30 years of combined service in the U.S. Navy and Federal Government. His experience and accomplishments include holding the title of Surface Warfare Officer, Engineering Duty Officer, Technical Warrant Holder (Command and Control), Deputy Program Manager, Chief Technology Officer, and Chief System Engineer for the U.S. Navy.

Previously, Mr. Armantrout served in the United States Navy. He was assigned to the Space and Naval Warfare Systems Command (SPAWAR), San Diego, Calif., from 1996 to 1999, and worked in the Navy Command and Control Program Office, PMW 157. He served as System Engineer and Project Officer for GCCS-M and multiple software sub-systems. He then transferred to the Advanced Tactical Data Link Systems Program Office, PMW 159, and worked TADIL data integration into GCCS-M and Joint systems, Joint Interface Control Officer Support System development and installation of shipboard data link systems.

After SPAWAR, he was assigned to the Navy Personnel Command/Bureau of Personnel (BUPERS), PERS-445, Engineering Duty Officer Assignments as the CDRILCDR 1440 Detailer.

Following the BUPERS tour, he reported to PEO C4I and served as Deputy Program Manager for both Naval Combat Support Systems (PMW 151) and Carrier Integration (PMW 750).

Mr. Armantrout graduated from Purdue University, West Lafayette, Ind., in 1987 as a Distinguished Military Graduate in Aerospace Engineering. He earned a Master's degree in Aerospace Engineering from the Naval Postgraduate School in Monterey, Calif., with a specialty in Weapon Systems Engineering. Most recently, Mr. Armantrout has earned a Master's degree in Business Administration from Webster University. He also has his Defense Acquisition Workforce Improvement Act (DAWIA) Program Management Level III certification. He is a member of the Department of Defense Acquisition Corps, Armed Forces Communications and Electronics Association (AFCEA), the National Defense Industrial Association (NDIA), and the Association of the United States Army (AUSA).
