

Ms. Ruthann Reese is the Director for Policy and Plans for the Joint Technical Networking Center (JTNC) in San Diego, California. She is responsible for operational oversight within the JTNC. Prior to her current assignment, she was the Director of Operations for JPEO JTRS and the Director of Acquisition, overseeing the execution of five ACAT 1-D programs totaling more than \$8B.

Ms. Reese has more than 30 years of service in the Federal Government. Her experience and accomplishments include information technology, Command, Control, Communications, Computers, and Intelligence (C4I), Fleet operations in the largest Naval Area of Responsibility (AoR), technical experience in laboratory environments, Program Management experience at a systems command, and Senior Acquisition oversight in a Joint Program Executive Office over multiple ACAT 1-D Joint programs.

Ms. Reese served as the Assistant Program Manager for a Navy Command and Control Program (Operations Support System and Joint Operational Tactical System); and an ACAT 1 AM Deputy Program Manager for the Defense

Management System. The PEO for Information Technology personally selected Ms. Reese to be the Deputy Program Manager of the largest program (both in funding and scope) for information technology.

From 2002-2005, Ms. Reese was the Director, Chief Information Officer (CIO) Operations for Command, Control, Communications, Computers, and Intelligence (C4I). In this role, she oversaw the Pacific Fleet (PACFLT) Headquarters, and all PACFLT Regions, directed the Information Technology, Information Assurance, C4I efforts and led several efforts for human capital strategy, including the standup of two major systems commands.

A graduate of San Diego State, Ms. Reese received her bachelor's in business administration and a Master's of Science degree from the Industrial College of the Armed Forces (ICAF) in Military Resource Strategy. Her certification includes Defense Acquisition Professional Community Level III. In 2002, Ms. Reese was honored with the Navy Meritorious Civilian Service award.
