BLUF

Requirements –

- **Within 3 months of PRD or approved release from unit**
- **Not subject to HYT limitations**
- **Security Clearance – secret or above**
- **100% Medical, Dental, Physical readiness**
- **Family Care Plan in place**

Be prepared to –

- **Attend up to 84 drills per year**
- **Perform more than 1 AT, if needed**
- **Submit last 5 years of evals/fitreps**
- **Submit last 5 PFA records**
- **Submit civilian resume & military bio**
- **Waive dwell time, if necessary**
