


INDUSTRY ENGAGEMENT

A collective approach between the Program Management Offices (PMOs), Industry, and the IC will ensure that assessments consider acquisition criteria and tech-insertion options in support of enterprise-wide needs.




AUTHORITY PEO EIS instruction to all PEO EIS PMOs.

VISION Engage industry in an environment where the speed of industry innovation is mechanized and works with the Navy on ECs in a highly interactive model.


ALIGNING NEEDS

- 2 PEO EIS groups needs into technical domains and prioritizes them to provide guidance to the IC.
