At the same time, an email notification will be received by the NIAPS CM. **PLEASE NOTE:** It is suggested that you hold off on accessing Dimensions until the NIAPS CM contacts you with directions on how to access the correct NIAPS Request form within Dimensions. Accessing and completing the correct NIAPS Request form is the first step in requesting your product be considered for inclusion on a NIAPS release.
