

DoD Information Technology Portfolio Repository (DITPR)/DON Application and Database Management System (DADMS)

Department of Defense (DoD) Information Technology Portfolio Repository (DITPR)/Department of Navy (DON) Application and Database Management System (DADMS) are the DoD and DON Information Technology (IT) registry systems.

DITPR is used by all DoD components to maintain a comprehensive, consolidated inventory of unclassified, mission-critical and mission-essential systems (including National Security Systems) and their interfaces. DITPR supports IT investment review and portfolio management.

DADMS is the DON's authoritative data source for system, application, database, network, and server information. DADMS supports IT baseline and cost control efforts assigned to the Office of the Chief of Naval Operations by the Vice Chief of Naval Operations. DADMS serves as the platform for the DITPR-DON, the DON's feeder system to DITPR.

Tech Refresh

Due to the nature of its antiquated software, DITPR/DADMS was non-sustainable. The software was obsolete and posed potential security risks. To address this issue and add improvements, DITPR/DADMS underwent a Technical Refresh (Tech Refresh). The Tech Refresh made DITPR/DADMS compliant with mandated security requirements for long-term operational sustainment of information.

The DITPR/DADMS Tech Refresh, completed in June 2016, replaced antiquated and non-sustainable Government-Off-The-Shelf (GOTS) software with Commercial-Off-The-Shelf (COTS) software that replicated existing system functionality, which benefited DITPR/DADMS by:

- Improving system security, usability, and availability
- Increasing ease of future system upgrades
- Provide long-term operational sustainment of information
- More efficiently supporting changing stakeholder needs.
