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Space and Naval Warfare Systems Command Awards Contract

SAN DIEGO -Data Link Solutions, Cedar Rapids, Iowa, is being awarded a \$24,629,268 firm-fixed-price delivery order under a previously awarded contract (N00039-10-D-0031) for Multifunctional Information Distribution System-Low Volume Terminals (MIDS-LVTs). The MIDS-LVT provides secure, high capacity, jam resistant, digital data and voice communications capability for Navy, Air Force and Army platforms. This delivery order combines purchases for the United States (11 percent) and the governments of Finland (38 percent), Pakistan (46 percent) and Hungary (5 percent) under the Foreign Military Sales program. Work will be performed in Wayne, N.J. (50 percent), and Cedar Rapids, Iowa (50 percent), and is expected to be completed by Feb. 28, 2012. Contract funds in the amount of \$636,195 will expire at the end of the current fiscal year. This contract was competitively procured via the Space and Naval Warfare E-commerce website, with two offers received. The Space and Naval Warfare Systems Command in San Diego, Calif., is the contracting activity.
