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Space and Naval Warfare Systems Command Awards Contract

SAN DIEGO – ViaSat, Carlsbad, Calif., is being awarded a \$15,819,052 firm-fixed-price delivery order for Multifunctional Information Distribution System-Low Volume Terminals (MIDS-LVTs). The MIDS-LVT provides secure, high capacity, jam resistant, digital data and voice communications capability for U.S. Navy, U.S. Marine Corps, U.S. Air Force and U.S. Army platforms. This delivery order combines purchases for the U.S. (21percent) and the government of Turkey (79 percent) under the Foreign Military Sales Program.

Work will be performed in Carlsbad, Calif., (30 percent), in various other sites worldwide (70 percent) and is expected to be completed by February 29, 2016.

Contract funds in the amount of \$229,413 will expire at the end of the current fiscal year.

This contract was competitively procured under a multiple award contract (MAC) with two proposals solicited and two offers received via the SPAWAR E-commerce website. The synopsis was released via the Federal Business Opportunities website for the initial MAC awards.
