Senior Chief Frazier was born in Shreveport, Louisiana on December 31, 1975 and is a native of New Orleans, Louisiana. She enlisted in the Navy October 3rd, 1994 in Shreveport, Louisiana as a Cryptologic Technician Communications (CTO) until Fiscal Year 2006 when the "CTO" rating was officially merged with the Information System Technician (IT) rating.

She reported to Recruit Training Command, Great Lakes, Illinois for Recruit Basic Training and continued onto CTO "A" School at Naval Technical Training Center, Corry Station, Pensacola, Florida. In June 1995, she reported to Naval Security Group Activity (NSGA) WESTPAC, Deddo, Guam for her first overseas shore tour as a CTO and was promoted to Petty Officer Third Class. In June 1997, she reported to NSGA San Diego as an Automated Message Handling System Administrator, where she was promoted to Petty Officer Second Class then on to Pensacola, Florida for "C" school. After, successfully completing the Cryptologic System/Network Administrator course at the University of West Florida, Pensacola, Florida in July 2000, she was later transferred to the National Security Agency Special United States Liaison Office (NSA\SUSLO) at the American Embassy in London, England working as the Communications Leading Petty Officer (LPO) and was promoted to Petty Officer First Class.

In July 2003, she reported to United States Central Command (USCENTCOM) as the Communications LPO and worked directly with Allied Forces. Later, she received follow-on orders to another "C" School. Upon completion of Communications Information Manager course she reported to COMSUBGRU SEVEN in September 2006, working directly for the Office of Naval Intelligence (ONI) SPINTCOMM in which she also earned an Associates of Arts in General Studies from the University of Maryland. In September 2009, she completed the Advanced Network Analyst course on Ford Island, Hawaii, and in December of the same year she reported to USS ESSEX (LHD 2) in Sasebo, Japan where she served as the Automated Data Processing Leading Chief Petty Officer (LCPO). During that assignment she earned both Enlisted Surface and Aviation Warfare Specialist Qualifications and was inducted as Chief Information Systems Technician.

October 2011, she reported to Gulfport, Mississippi for Expeditionary Combat Skills Training. Once she effectively completed the course she transferred to Coastal Riverine Group Two Detachment, Manama, Bahrain and worked as the N6 Communications Officer and Communications LCPO, earned her Expeditionary Warfare qualification as well as a Bachelor of Science Degree in Computer Studies from the University of Maryland. In July 2013, she reported to Walter Reed National Military Medical Center, served dual hatted as the Senior Enlisted Leader for the National Intrepid Center of Excellence and the Warrior Family Coordination Cell. In June 2014, she was selected and promoted to Senior Chief Petty Officer. Currently, she is assigned to SPAWAR Space Field Activity, Chantilly, Virginia as the Command Senior Enlisted Leader.

She is authorized to wear the Defense Meritorious Service Medal, Joint Service Commendation Medal, Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medal (2 Awards), Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal (3 Awards), and various unit and campaign awards.
