Forms: a) DD 2807-1
b) DD 2808
c) Special Duty Medical Abstract (SDMA)
d) MILPERSMAN 1220-100, Exhibit 8

Periodicity: within one year of initial application for training and every 5 years until age 50, every 2 years thereafter

Prerequisites: (Within 90 days of the exam date)

- a) Visual Acuity/Refraction, Color Vision, Field of vision, Depth perception
- b) Audiogram
- c) Dental Type 2 Exam
- d) Chest X-ray (PA & LAT)
- e) EKG
- f) PPD
- g) LABS: CBC, UA with microscopy, Fasting glucose, HIV, HCV AB. PSA if over age 36, Stool guiac if HAPS/HALO.

1. Have member complete the demographics and medical history portions of the DD2807-1 and DD2808.
2. If patient is a candidate for initial training review and record all required immunizations and Lab results on the 2808, Exhibit 8.
3. Record all Special Studies on DD 2808 in the corresponding blocks.
4. Schedule member an appointment with a UMO.
6. Upon completion of the medical appointment, verify that the DMO has signed the physical and marked the member PQ or NPQ for SO/SWCC/EOD. Verify UMO has signed the SDMA. File the original in the member's medical record IAW MANMED CH-16.

ALSO DO Explosive Handler and Parachute exams!!!

REMEMBER - the MANMED requires an annual PHA for all members on diving duty to include documentation of skin cancer screening!
