

LAWRENCE WARRIOR CHARTER & EXPECTATIONS

Overview: WILLIAM P. LAWRENCE Sailors are Warriors who base their conduct on the Navy Core Values of Honor, Courage, and Commitment. These expectations are a guideline which Warriors use to uphold the values of the NAVY, SHIP, and SELF.

- **Respect**

- LAWRENCE Warriors treat not only those senior to them with respect, but all those they meet. This includes peers and those junior to them.
- LAWRENCE Warriors respect the diversity between individuals and use that diversity to strengthen the ship and complete the mission.

- **Integrity**

- LAWRENCE Warriors are honest not only with their words but with their actions as well.
- LAWRENCE Warriors conduct themselves in accordance with the Navy's Core Values regardless of who is watching, on or off duty.

- **Knowledge**

- LAWRENCE Warriors use the Enlisted Surface Warfare Specialist program as the base of their knowledge of their ship and continue their pursuit of knowledge daily.
- LAWRENCE Warriors train, mentor, and share their knowledge with their shipmates.

- **Dedication**

- LAWRENCE Warriors work to the best of their ability to finish every job they start.
- LAWRENCE Warriors are proactive and understand that teamwork leads to success which results in mission accomplishment.

- **Presence**

- LAWRENCE Warriors demonstrate the highest standards of military bearing and grooming standards. This includes ensuring their shipmates are also within regulations.
- LAWRENCE Warriors are Naval Ambassadors for their ship, shipmates, and the Navy, and thus work to present a good image in both word and action.
