## **CTR1(IDW/SW) Patricia H. Madigan** **Navy Information Operation Command (NIOC) Hawaii**

Petty Officer Madigan was born in Elmira, NY. Shortly after graduating from high school, she reported to Recruit Training Command Great Lakes for Basic Training. Upon completion, she reported to Naval Technical Training Center (NTTC) Corry Station for Cryptologic Technician Collections (CTR) 'A' school. Her first tour of duty was at Naval Security Group Activity, Menwith Hill, in Harrogate, England. Follow-on tours included Naval Security Group Activity, Kumia; USS NORMANDY (CG 60); USS PORTER (DDG 78); and Center for Information Dominance Learning Site, San Diego.

In July 2011, Petty Officer Madigan reported to Navy Information Operation Command (NIOC) Hawaii and immediately accepted Individual Augmentation orders to Afghanistan where she spent 11 months as the Officer in Charge of a tactical support operations unit. Upon returning to NIOC Hawaii in November of 2012, she assumed the duties as Non-Commissioned Officer in Charge to a Joint Service operational branch as well as Department Leading Petty Officer.

Petty Officer Madigan's academic achievements include an Associate of Arts in Humanities from Coastline Community College, and an Associate of Science in Management and a Bachelor of Science in Diplomacy and Military Studies from Hawaii Pacific University.

Petty Officer Madigan's personal awards include the Defense Meritorious Service Medal, Joint Service Commendation Medal, Joint Service Achievement Medal, and Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal (three awards).
