

Grade: E1-E4 (35%); E5-E9 (21%)

CIRCUMSTANCES:

49% off base

Weapon of choice: alcohol

CHALLENGES

- **Fleet/CO ownership of sexual assaults in each command**
- **Cultural change**
- **Bystander intervention**
- **Victims reporting**

411 unrestricted reports – 170 restricted reports – 611 known victims
