## **HM1(SW/EXW) Mahtob M. Johnson**

**USS ARLEIGH BURKE (DDG 51)**

Petty Officer Johnson was born in Washington D.C. She entered the Navy on August 30, 2000. After completing Boot Camp and Hospital Corps "A" School in April 2001, she reported to Naval Hospital, Beaufort, South Carolina.

In 2003, she reported to USS SAIPAN (LHA 2) as a general duty Corpsman where she obtained her designation as a Surface Warrior. Subsequently, she served as the Operative Support Leading Petty Officer at Naval Medical Center Portsmouth (NMCP). While assigned to NMCP, she dedicated herself to the completion of an Associate of Arts Degree in Health Care Administration and Management, graduating from University of Phoenix in March 2009.

While assigned to NMCP, HM1 Johnson was promoted to the rank of First Class Petty Officer. Upon completion of her tour at NMCP, she reported to Surface Warfare Medical Institute for Surface Force Independent Duty School where she graduated as the honor graduate with honors and distinction. Upon completion of Independent Duty Corpsman school, she reported to Field Medical Training in Camp Lejeune, North Carolina in route to reporting to Naval Special Warfare Logistical Support Unit 2 (NSW LOGSU-2) in Little Creek, Virginia.

While only on board NSW LOGSU-2 for a short period of time, HM1 Johnson was Leading Petty Officer and earned her Enlisted Expeditionary Warfare qualification. She then took hot-fill orders to USS ARLEIGH BURKE (DDG 51) where she is presently stationed.

Petty Officer Johnson's personal awards include the Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medal, Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal (three awards), Good Conduct Medal (four awards), Humanitarian Award, National Defense Service Medal, Sea Service Deployment Ribbon (two awards), and Overseas Service Ribbon.
