Enabling Objectives

- **List eligibility requirements for Officer commissioning programs in accordance with Enlisted to Officer Commissioning Programs Application Administrative Manual, OPNAVINST 1420.1 (Series)**

Purpose

- **Provide opportunities for enlisted personnel to obtain a commission in the U.S. Navy**

Basic Requirements

- **Must be a U.S. Citizen**
- **Physical**
- **Age**
- **Testing**
- **Recommended by Commanding Officer**

Naval Academy

- Provides 4 years of college education
- Must be 17 and not older than 23 on 1 July of entrance year
- Unmarried, no legal responsibility to support others

Naval Academy Preparatory School

- Provides intensive instruction and preparation for the academic, military, and physical training curriculum at the Naval Academy
- Offered in a direct appointment to the Naval Academy
- Must be no older than 22 as of 1 July of the entrance year

Seaman to Admiral 21 (STA-21)

- **Minimum 1000 SAT/41 ACT**
- **2 phases**
 - **8 weeks at NSI**
 - **36 months at NROTC university**
- **Receive full pay and allowance**

Medical Enlisted Commissioning Program

- Provides opportunity to earn nursing degree and commission
- 36 months to complete degree
- Minimum 1000 SAT/42 ACT
- Can be up to 42 years old

Officer Candidate School

- **Commissioning Program for Sailors who possess a Bachelors degree**
- **12 weeks of officer candidate indoctrination and training**
- **22 different fields available**

Other Commissioning Opportunities

- **Medical Service Corps In-Service Procurement Program (MSC-IPP)**
- **Limited Duty Officer (LDO)**
- **Chief Warrant Officer (CWO)**
