Commencing September 2019

Distance Learning Program using a Web-based, Virtual Classroom Environment

The EMBA is a nonresident, part-time online program for military officers O-4 and senior (O-3 admitted by waiver), and federal employees GS-12 and above or equivalent. During this 24-month distance-learning program, students acquire the latest knowledge and skills in financial management, acquisition, program management, policymaking, and decision-making. The team-based curriculum includes the latest in defense-relevant studies. Students who complete the degree program also earn DAU Level II equivalencies for all program management functional training. Navy officers receive a subspecialty code in financial management 3100P.

The EMBA program is delivered over the Internet using a web-based, virtual classroom tool with synchronous, real-time interaction between faculty and students. These online technologies use collaborative communication tools that deliver learning opportunities to students regardless of geographical location. Students participate in class one day per week, approximately 6-7 hours per day. To use the virtual classroom, students will need Internet access and audio-video capabilities suitable for web-enabled interactions with instructors and other students.

The EMBA program starts with a one-week residency requirement at the NPS campus in Monterey, CA. This week includes an orientation and a graduate-level course. A second week of resident instruction is required during year two of the program. Other than these two visits to NPS in Monterey, students complete all instruction from their home locations. The price is \$2250 per course. Eligible active duty DoN officers are mission funded.
