1. Date and Location

a. This administrative selection board, consisting of you as president, the officers listed in enclosure (1) as members, and the personnel listed in enclosure (2) as administrative support staff, is ordered to convene virtually at the Navy Personnel Command, Millington, TN, at 1200, 8 November 2018, or as soon as practicable thereafter.

b. The board shall proceed in accordance with all guidance in this letter and the FY-20 Administrative Selection Board Precept, reference (a).

2. Function. The function of the board is to recommend Regular Navy applicants for participation in the FY-20 Navy Active-Duty Nuclear Limited Duty Officer (LDO) In-Service Procurement Program. The selection board shall consider carefully, without prejudice or partiality, the record of every eligible applicant. The records and names of all eligible applicants, determined as of the date the board convenes, will be furnished to the board.

3. Selection Board Authorized Selections. Per reference (b), the board is authorized to recommend 42 primary and eight alternate candidates for appointment to LDO in the grade of ensign.

4. Additional Guidance. The below information is provided to clarify community requirements and any specific needs, but in no way should replace the Best and Fully Qualified Standard of reference (a).

Subj: ORDER CONVENING THE FY-20 NAVY ACTIVE-DUTY NUCLEAR  
LIMITED DUTY OFFICER IN-SERVICE PROCUREMENT PROGRAM

a. Applicants are required to be pre-screened by the staff of the Director, Naval Nuclear Propulsion to be eligible for selection by the board.

b. Applicants with CVN experience should have completed qualification as a Propulsion Plant Watch Supervisor (PPWS) or for submarine applicants, Engineering Watch Supervisor (EWS).

c. Nuclear enlisted personnel do not qualify as Propulsion Plant Watch Officer unless they are serving on a multi-reactor ship and have special permission from Naval Reactors.

d. Only a select few nuclear enlisted personnel have the opportunity to qualify as Engineering Officer of the Watch at land-based prototypes.

e. Those who have not qualified PPWS or EWS should not be considered.

5. The board need not select to the numbers provided. The authorized number to select should only be attained if there are a sufficient number of candidates determined fully qualified.

2. Membership Waiver:
