# Certification/Training Notes

- ❖ Members in positions requiring Level II or Level III certification are not required to become certified at the lower level(s). However, any mandatory prerequisite courses must be completed. Note, some career fields mandate that lower level training be satisfied
- ❖ Prerequisites identified for ON-LINE courses are recommended, not mandatory
- ❖ Resident courses can be requested before prerequisites are completed, but they must be completed NLT 15 days prior to the class convening date
- ❖ Member must meet all requirements in place at the time of certification application. So if a course is added prior to applying for certification, it must be satisfied
- ❖ When requesting a resident course, choose the location that is highlighted (Cost Effective Location (CEL)). If no availability for remainder of FY, pursue non-CEL locations for possible reservation
- ❖ A resident course can be requested for multiple dates
- ❖ FY21 DAU schedule for Q3 and Q4 should be available late January 2021
- ❖ Must achieve primary certification before pursuing subsidiary certification(s)
- ❖ If using self-declared experience to meet the respective experience requirement, choose the radio button in the experience section of the application and provide supporting documentation
