<u>Program Authorization</u>: Reserve Component (RC) Naval Aviator (designator 1315) or Naval Flight Officer (NFO) (designator 1325) for other service veterans. Aviation Officer Community Manager Reserve Component Branch (BUPERS-351D) is the RC aviation officer community manager.

- 1. Program Authority: Title 10 U.S. Code sections 12201 to 12209.
- 2. Cancellation: Program Authorization 201 of May 2013.
- 3. Quota: As prescribed by the Deputy Chief of Naval Operations (Manpower, Personnel, Training and Education) (DCNO N1).

4. Qualifications:

- a. Citizenship: Applicants must be U.S. citizens.
- b. Age: Applicants must be at least 21 years old and less than 42 years old at the time of commissioning. Waivers beyond age 54 will not be considered.
- c. Education: Applicants must have a baccalaureate degree from a regionally accredited institution.
- d. Physical: In line with the Manual of the Medical Department, Chapter 15, to include an aviation physical examination from a qualified flight surgeon to determine aeronautical adaptability.
 - e. Duty Preference: Not applicable.
 - f. Program Specific Requirements:
- (1) Must have completed Active Duty military service obligation in another U.S. Armed Service or the U.S. Coast Guard as a rated aviator in good standing.
 - (2) Must have been selected by a Navy Reserve force squadron aviator selection board.
- (3) Military work experience must be validated with submission of the applicant's service record, to include the past three performance evaluations, positions held, flight experience, military training and education attended/completed and all previous Active/Reserve oaths of office and all DD 214, Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty.
- (4) Application for appointment as a naval aviator or NFO in the Navy Reserve shall be reviewed and recommended for approval by Navy Personnel Command, Reserve Personnel Management (PERS-9) and BUPERS-351D prior to approval by Commander, Navy Recruiting Command (CNRC). PERS-9 and BUPERS-351D screening shall include, at a minimum:

- (a) Endorsement from a Navy Reserve force squadron commanding officer. This endorsement shall include the results of a squadron aviator selection board approving the candidate for selection into a squadron Selected Reserve (SELRES) billet for duty in a flying status involving flying.
- (b) Flight physical results, including endorsement from the Naval Operational Medical Institute (NOMI) stating that the officer is physically qualified for naval aviation.
- (c) Review of service record for performance, determination of pay entry base date/rank and a check to ensure the applicant will not be subject to attrition provisions of Chapter 1407 of U.S. Code upon commissioning in the Navy Reserve.
 - (d) Review of both military and civilian flight training and experience.
 - (e) Past three performance evaluations.
- 5. <u>Waivers</u>: In cases where the applicant does not meet all of the qualifications, but otherwise has an exceptional record or proven skillset required by the Navy, a waiver may be authorized in limited numbers. If a waiver is requested, then follow the steps below prior to the convening of the selection board.
- a. Routing: Applicant will route waiver request to CNRC. CNRC will forward to Director, Military Community Management (BUPERS-3) for adjudication.
 - b. Approval Authority: BUPERS-3.
 - c. Notifying the Applicant: CNRC.
- 6. <u>Accession Source</u>: Civilians (U.S. citizens) who previously held officer commissions and have completed full military service obligation with the U.S. Army, U.S. Air Force, U.S. Marine Corps or U.S. Coast Guard.
- 7. <u>Indoctrination</u>: Selectees must complete all accession training requirements within 1 year of commissioning.
- 8. Enlistment: Not applicable.
- 9. Constructive Entry Credit: Not applicable.
- 10. Appointment:
- a. Candidates will be commissioned in the unrestricted line of the U.S. Navy as a lieutenant junior grade, lieutenant or lieutenant commander (depending on entry grade service credit), designator 1315 or 1325.

- b. Warrant officers certified as pilots from other services will be appointed as ensign, designator 1315.
- c. Entry Grade Service Credit. CNRC shall provide entry grade service credit to maintain appointment paygrade as well as time-in-grade. CNRC shall provide current statement of service, prepared by Navy Personnel Command, Reserve Officer Branch (PERS-911). Total credit to establish paygrade shall not exceed 15 years and rank of lieutenant commander.

11. Service Obligation:

- a. Selectees will incur an 8-year ready reserve obligation, the first 3 years of which must be served in the SELRES.
 - b. Selectees must maintain eligibility for worldwide assignment.
- 12. Pay and Allowances: Not applicable.
