TRICARE senior pharmacy benefit details announced

The Department of Defense has announced that on April 1, 2001, uniformed services beneficiaries 65 years of age and older will begin receiving pharmacy benefits provided by the 2001 National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA). An estimated 1.4 million beneficiaries are eligible for the benefit.

The new program will limit out-of-pocket costs, and increase access to the National Mail Order Pharmacy (NMOP) and retail pharmacies that are part of the Department of Defense (DoD) network, which include many major chain drug stores. In addition, beneficiaries may use non-network retail pharmacies.

“Drug therapy, for many of our older retired servicemembers, is one of their greatest and most costly medical needs. This is a comprehensive drug benefit that makes pharmacy care accessible and affordable. This expanded benefit should contribute significantly to their quality of life,” stated J. Jarrett Clinton, M.D., acting assistant secretary of Defense for Health Affairs.

Beneficiaries who are 65 years of age and older will not pay enrollment fees or annual premiums for their TRICARE pharmacy benefits, but they will pay modest co-pays when they use NMOP and retail network pharmacies. In addition, beneficiaries will also be able to use non-network pharmacies; however, this option will entail a slightly higher co-pay and deductible. In the past, only those beneficiaries who were eligible for Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC) benefits and the Pharmacy Redesign Pilot Program (PRPP) were able to enjoy modest out-of-pocket costs through the NMOP and retail pharmacy network. The BRAC pharmacy benefit and the Pharmacy Redesign Pilot Program have been replaced by the new program.

By law, to use the TRICARE retail and mail order benefit, beneficiaries age 65 and over must

be eligible for Medicare Part A and enrolled in Part B. There is an exception: Those who turn 65 before April 1, 2001, are eligible for the benefit, even if they are not enrolled in Medicare Part B.

Effective Oct. 1, 2001, Medicare-eligible military beneficiaries become eligible for all other TRICARE benefits. The law requires that all Medicare-eligible beneficiaries, regardless of age, must be enrolled in Medicare Part B to receive the other TRICARE benefits; and they are advised to enroll in Part B as soon as they are eligible. The annual open season for enrollment in Medicare Part B is Jan. 1 through March 31. Information about Medicare enrollment is available at local Social Security Administration offices, or on the Medicare Web Site at <http://www.medicare.gov/Basics/Overview.asp>.

Retired beneficiaries living overseas can use their TRICARE benefit at overseas pharmacies, but they will need to submit their pharmacy claims for reimbursement. They also will be able to use the NMOP, if certain requirements are met. Federal and state legal restrictions apply to the prescribing, dispensing and mailing of prescription drugs, so the NMOP can only mail to APOs and FPOs, which are part of the U.S. Postal Service. Also, the NMOP can only fill prescriptions written by providers licensed to practice in the United States.

The NMOP offers the largest discount to DoD beneficiaries. It is convenient for filling prescriptions for chronic conditions like high blood pressure or diabetes. The retail network pharmacy program can be used for short-term, immediate use medications. Lists of TRICARE network pharmacies will be available from regional TRICARE contractors. Beneficiaries who use non-network pharmacies will have to meet an annual deductible, incur a higher co-pay, and pay the entire bill up front, then file a claim for appropriate

We have provided you with a list with mailing addresses of your council members. Write to them and let them know your thoughts. On a different tack, when was the last time you thought about the Navy Home? What a place! I have the opportunity to visit once every three months and really look forward to the trip. The home is right on the beach with a beautiful view of the Gulf. Some of the features include a movie theater, bowling alley, swimming pool, Navy Exchange, post office, barber and beauty shops, chapel, great grounds, casinos nearby and great chow. SECNAV Retiree Council seeks members for 2002

If you would like the opportunity to serve the retired community, please consider applying for one of the vacancies on the Secretary of the Navy's Retiree Council (RC). RC members are expected to be available to assist their area Retired Activities Officers (RAOs) throughout the year. They are also expected to work closely with regional or area commanders to gather input and concerns from retirees, for presentation at the annual council meeting, which is held in the Spring. The council maintains a broad cross-representation of retirees. Volunteer service in an RAO is an excellent credential; however, retirees with specific background and experience in the fields of retirement services, medical, military compensation, and legal services should also consider applying. Application letters must be received at the Retired Activities Branch by July 31, 2001. The following information should be provided:

- Full name, address, phone number and E-mail address (if applicable.)
- Rank (at time of retirement).
- Social Security Account Number.
- A brief statement on how you can contribute to the RC.
- Resume (include any service to Navy retired community).
- Any other applicable information.

All submissions will be carefully reviewed, and nominees will be selected based upon a number of factors, including the applicant's expertise in a particular area, experience with issues affecting retirees, previous or continuing service to the retired community, retiree status (sometimes there are specific slots open for reserve retirees, for example), geographic location, etc.

Those nominees selected for appointment to the RC will be notified by mail from the Office of the Assistant Secretary of the Navy (Manpower and Reserve Affairs), which is the office responsible for coordination of the RC. The term of office for RC members is normally three years. RC members are brought back on special active duty orders for the duration of the week-long annual meeting, which is held in Washington, D.C. For more information call 1-800-255-8950, ext. 44308. reimbursement.

One of the most important steps eligible beneficiaries can take to be sure they can use the expanded pharmacy benefit is to update their Defense Enrollment Eligibility Reporting System (DEERS) record with their correct address and any changes in family status, such as marriage, divorce, birth or adoption.

Eligible beneficiaries may update their addresses in DEERS in a number of ways: by visiting local personnel offices that have an ID card facility; by calling the Defense Manpower Data Center Support Office (DSO) Telephone Center at 800-538-9552 (The best time to call the Telephone Center is Wednesday through Friday, between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. (Pacific Time) to avoid delays); by Faxing changes to (831) 655-8317; by mailing the

change information to the DSO, Attn: COA, 400 Gigling Road, Seaside, CA 93955-6771; by visiting a Military Treatment Facility; by E-mailing information to addrinfo@osd.pentagon.mil and including the sponsor's name and social security number, name(s) of other family members affected by the address change, effective date of address information, and telephone number (to include area code), if available. Internet users should use all lowercase letters because some e-mail systems are case sensitive.

To change information in DEERS other than address data, beneficiaries may visit an ID card facility, or mail or Fax changes with appropriate documentation to the address or fax numbers provided above. Beneficiaries should contact the nearest military ID card facility for more information or required documentation.

Long-term care insurance

The January–March 2001 edition of *Shift Colors* cited a provision in the National Defense Authorization Act for 2001, which included a long-term care insurance initiative. The new law provides that the program must be effective no later than 18 months after enactment, that is, October 2002 at the latest.

The Office of Personnel and Management (OPM) is working

with consultants and actuaries to develop the specifics for the contract. Presently there are no underwriters for this insurance.

We will provide additional information as it becomes available.

Keep SBP information current

Information about your Survivor Benefit Plan (SBP) election appears on the reverse side of your Retiree Account Statement (RAS). The RAS is distributed annually, by the Defense Finance and Accounting Service-Cleveland (DFAS-CL) and any time there is a change in your pay. It is important that you and your spouse be aware of your SBP election and the financial implications, should you pass away before your spouse.

If you are an SBP participant (whether premiums are being deducted or are suspended), you have **one year** to enroll any newly acquired spouse or child.

If you divorce and are required to continue coverage for your former spouse, you or your spouse must provide a copy of your divorce decree and a cover letter specifically requesting continuation in SBP under the former spouse category within **one year** to DFAS-CL. If you do not provide the divorce decree, your former spouse, or their attorney may do so and have the coverage “deemed” on their behalf. If you divorce and provide your divorce decree without a cover letter, your SBP coverage may be terminated.

Be sure to maintain your current beneficiary information with both DFAS-CL and the Defense Enrollment Eligibility Reporting System (DEERS).

Lifetime pharmaceuticals for overseas retirees

Retired beneficiaries living overseas can use the new pharmacy benefit at overseas pharmacies, but they will need to submit claims for reimbursement. They may also use the National Mail Order Pharmacy under two conditions: (1) they must have an APO or FPO address and (2) their prescriptions must be written by providers licensed to

practice in the United States.

This valuable benefit begins April 1, 2001.

To qualify, overseas retirees must be eligible for Medicare Part A and be enrolled in Part B, except that those who turn 65 before April 1, 2001, will qualify for the benefit, even if they are not enrolled in Medicare Part B.

Should I petition the Board for Correction of Naval Records?

In the October-December 2000 issue of *Shift Colors*, a story was published regarding the Survivor Benefit Plan (SBP) administrative error correction/BCNR process. As we reported then, many retired Sailors phone the Defense Finance and Accounting Service-Cleveland (DFAS-CL) shortly after retirement to inquire about deductions from their retired pay account. One such deduction is for SBP. If you are a recent retiree (retired within one year) and have an SBP problem or question, please feel free to bring it to our attention

here in Millington. We are generally able to solve most problems over the phone, or very quickly using the mail system. From time to time it will be necessary to file a petition with the BCNR, however, if you are a recent retiree, give us an opportunity to serve you first. If your situation is beyond our legal scope of authority to assist, we will guide you in the right direction. If you have further questions phone the SBP Program Manager, Mr. Basil Coleman at (800) 255-8950 extension 4-4304.

DD 214 crucial when applying for Social Security

The Retired Activities Branch continues to receive calls from retirees who have applied for Social Security benefits and were informed that their DD 214s were required for benefits. For that reason we repeat:

If you are approaching your 62nd birthday and are preparing to apply for Social Security benefits, you should know these facts.

- You may apply for benefits three months before your 62nd birthday.
- It is advised that you call the Social Security Administration Office for an appointment and a list of documents and information necessary for your application of benefits.
- Your application for benefits will not be processed without **all of your DD-214s** or

verification of military service. If you do not have that information, you may request copies from:

All requests must be written, dated and signed, and should include full name, rate/rank, Social Security Number, dates of service and date of birth. You may want to check out their Web Site at <http://www.nara.gov/regional/mpr.html> prior to making a request.

Navy Junior ROTC program seeks instructors

The Navy Junior Reserve Officers Training Corps (NJROTC) Program will expand from 490 to 562 high schools this fiscal year, with plans to add 138 more units during FY02 through FY05. This expansion will necessitate the hiring of over 500 additional instructors into the program to fill the new positions.

The current NJROTC program encompasses approximately 67,000 cadets and 1085 instructors. It is made up of units in 43 states, the District of Columbia, Italy, Japan and Guam, and is designed to promote patriotism, citizenship, self-discipline and leadership skills in high school students. The program includes a Naval Science curriculum with subjects such as naval history, oceanography, navigation, naval operations, and leadership. Additional activities include community service, orientation trips to military bases, sea cruises,

athletic, academic and drill events.

Instructors in this program are retired Navy, Marine Corps and Coast Guard officers and senior enlisted (E-6 to E-9) who have served a minimum of 20 years active duty or have retired under the Temporary Early Retirement Authority (TERA) and have been out of the service no more than six years. Instructors are hired as high school teachers, wear their uniforms, maintain current weight requirements and receive a salary at least equal to the difference between their retired pay and the active duty pay and allowances. Many instructors are paid considerably higher salaries.

Recent retirees may have opportunity to convert from VEAP to Montgomery GI Bill

If you were still on active duty on April 1, 2000, you may be eligible to enroll in the Montgomery GI Bill (MGIB) Program. Public Law 106-419 authorizes Sailors who participated in the Veterans Educational Assistance Program (VEAP) on or before Oct. 9, 1996 and served continuously from that date through April 1, 2000 the opportunity to enroll in the MGIB Program. "Participant" means you opened a VEAP account; however, there is no requirement to have money in the account. You can receive MGIB Program benefits even if you used your VEAP benefits.

Navy Personnel Command (PERS-604) will send enrollment packages out in April 2001 to those who retired since April 1, 2000. However, if you do not receive an enrollment package and believe you are eligible to convert, call Navy Personnel Command MGIB Customer Service Team at 800-962-1425.

You should carefully consider whether you want to convert from VEAP to the MGIB Program. In general, electing MGIB Program enrollment is a good idea if you plan to receive at least six months of training. The basic monthly rate under the MGIB Program is \$650 for 36 months

of full-time training (\$23,400). Under VEAP it's a maximum of \$300 a month for 27 months of full-time training or \$225 a month for 36 months of full-time training (\$8,100).

MGIB Program requires a nonrefundable \$2,700 contribution. VEAP allows you to contribute any amount up to \$2,700. If you stay in VEAP, any unused portion of your VEAP contributions is fully refundable to you.

Oct. 31, 2001 is the deadline to elect enrollment in the MGIB Program. If you do not receive an enrollment letter in May, contact the MGIB Customer Service Team.

Whether you elect or decline enrollment in the MGIB Program, mail your completed DD Form 2366 to Commander, Navy Personnel Command (PERS-604), 5720 Integrity Drive, Millington, Tenn., 38055-6040. Failure to provide PERS-604 a copy could delay receipt of your education benefits.

Survivor Benefit Plan (SBP)/Retired Serviceman's Family Protection Plan (RSFPP) Paid Up Provisions

Many of our readers continue to inquire about the paid up provisions of the Retired Serviceman's Family Protection Plan (RSFPP) and the Survivor Benefit Plan (SBP). The FY00 National Defense Authorization Act provided for a paid up provision for SBP. The provisions of that law **do not become effective until Oct. 1, 2008**. A member having reached 70 years of age, and having paid into the program for 30 years or more will be considered paid up and will no longer be required to pay premiums. Public Law 106-65, enacted

Oct. 5, 1999 outlined similar criteria for RSFPP participants. During the most recent open season enrollment period, a member was charged a one-time, buy-in premium in addition to the prospective monthly premium. The buy-in premium was due and payable in a lump sum payment at the time the member filed the election. A member who paid the lump sum, buy-in premium receives credit toward the 360 months (30 years) as if the member's retired pay had been reduced monthly for SBP premiums.

members. Enrollees in the program vary from newly retired service members with young children, for whom basic and preventive procedures, orthodontia and even dental accident coverage are of primary importance, to senior retirees and their family members with more specialized dental needs such as crowns, bridges and dentures.
