

Properly storing **YOUR FIREARM** can help **PREVENT SUICIDE.**




A few moments to retrieve and unlock a secured firearm can interrupt the impulse and open the door for help.



Store firearms unloaded with a gunlock in a secured cabinet, safe or case. Keep ammunition in a separate secured storage location.



Per NAVADMIN 263/14, Sailors can work with their commanding officers and health professionals to arrange safe storage of their private firearm during a high-risk period.
