Senior Chief Riley is a native of New Orleans, Louisiana. She enlisted in the Navy 03 October 1994 in Shreveport, Louisiana as Cryptologic Technician Communications until fiscal year 2006 when the rating was officially merged with the Information System Technician rating.

Reported to Recruit Training Command, Great Lakes, Illinois for Recruit Basic Training and continued onto CTO "A" School at Naval Technical Training Center, Corry Station, Pensacola, Florida. In June 1995, she reported to Naval Security Group Activity, WESTPAC, Dededo, Guam. In June 1997, she reported to Naval Security Group Activity, San Diego as an Automated Message Handling System Administrator. After, successful completion of the Cryptologic System/Network Administrator course at the University of West Florida, Pensacola, Florida in July 2000, she transferred to the National Security Agency Special United States Liaison Office at the American Embassy in London, England working as the Communications Leading Petty Officer.



In July 2003, she reported to United States Central Command as the Communications LPO and worked directly with Allied Forces. Upon completion of Communications Information Manager course she reported to Commander, Submarine Group Seven in September 2006, worked directly for the Office of Naval Intelligence SPINTCOMM. In September 2009, she completed the Advanced Network Analyst course on Ford Island, Hawaii, and in December of the same year she reported to USS ESSEX (LHD 2) in Sasebo, Japan where she served as the Automated Data Processing Leading Chief Petty Officer. During that assignment she was inducted as Chief Information Systems Technician.

October 2011, she transferred to Coastal Riverine Group Two Detachment, Manama, Bahrain and worked as the N6 Communications Officer and Communications LCPO. In July 2013, she reported to Walter Reed National Military Medical Center as a Navy Wounded Warrior, served dual-hatted as the Senior Enlisted Leader for the National Intrepid Center of Excellence and the Warrior Family Coordination Cell. Currently, assigned to NAVWAR Space Field Activity, Chantilly, Virginia as the Command Senior Enlisted Leader.

Senior Chief Riley has earned an Associates of Arts Degree in General Studies, Bachelor of Science Degree in Computer Studies and a Master Degree in Information Technology from the University of Maryland; Senior Enlisted Academy graduate, Class 200/Gray and CMC/COB Course graduate, Class 166 and earned her license and is ordained as an International Church of God in Christ Deaconess Missionary.
