Deputy Program Manager, Sea Warrior Program (PMW 240)



Kevin Allen is the Sea Warrior Program (PMW 240) Deputy Program Manager (DPM) since March 2016. As the DPM, Mr. Allen assists the Program Manager overseeing the Sea Warrior, a complex Information Technology (IT) program comprised of 70+ programs and projects and over 240 civilian and military personnel.

Mr. Allen began his federal service in 1999 at Naval Sea Systems Command (NAVSEA) where he was a member of the acquisition intern program. As part of this program Mr. Allen gained extensive acquisition experience by completing rotations through PMS 377, 378, 325, SUPSHIP San Diego, and Space and Naval Warfare Systems Command (SPAWAR) Systems Center San Diego. He subsequently accepted a position at SPAWAR Systems Center San Diego managing an Office of Naval Research (ONR) sponsored antenna development program. In 2001, he was selected as a platform manager supporting SPAWAR 054 responsible for the acquiring, integrating, installing, and testing all C4I systems on the T-AKE and Cobra Judy Replacement programs.

In 2005, Mr. Allen transferred to PMW 760 in PEO C4I with the standup of the C4I Integration Program Offices. He served as the Deputy Assistant Program Manager (DAPM) for Combatants until he was selected as the Principal Integration Program Manager (PIPM) for Combatants in 2006 responsible for the acquisition, integration, testing, and delivery of C4I systems on New Construction Combatants. In 2009, he was selected as the PAPM in PMW 150 for Support C2 responsible for the Naval Tactical Command Support System (NTCSS), Maintenance Figure of Merit (MFOM), and Bar Code Scanner Logistics Management Automated Information System (BCS LMAIS) programs. In 2012, he was selected as the PAPM in PMW 160 for Network Systems responsible for Consolidated Afloat Networks and Enterprise Systems (CANES), Integrated Shipboard Network System (ISNS), SCI Networks, and Combines Enterprise Regional Information Exchange System (CENTRIXS). In 2014, he was selected as the PMW 240 Principal Assistant Program Manager (PAPM) for Enterprise Business Services.

Mr. Allen graduated from the University of California, San Diego in 1996 with a Bachelors of Science degree in Mechanical Engineering. He graduated from the University of Virginia in 1998 with a Master's of Science degree in Mechanical Engineering.
