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## **Space and Naval Warfare Systems Command Contract Modification**

SAN DIEGO – Hewlett Packard Enterprise Services (HPES), Herndon, Va. was awarded a sole source modification to the continuity of services contract (CoSC) for Navy Marine Corps Intranet (NMCI). The modification includes increasing the contract ceiling by \$138,000,000, from \$5,603,792,250 to \$5,741,792,250, and adding an option to extend the period of performance by three months, from July 1, 2014 to Sept. 30, 2014.

The NMCI services are currently provided under the CoSC, which was awarded to HPES in order to continue providing NMCI information technology (IT) services following the expiration of the original NMCI contract. The CoSC contract period of performance for IT services was due to expire on June 30, 2014 and the contract ceiling would have been exceeded in June 2014 based on current requirements. The CoSC ensures that the scope of NMCI IT services and performance levels delivered are sustained until the Next Generation Enterprise Network contract is satisfactorily providing the replacement services.

This work is performed at nearly 2,500 Navy and Marine Corps locations worldwide, from major bases to single-user sites.

No funds will be placed on contract or obligated at the time of modification.
